Grazing outdoors 365 days a year



A low input system where the cattle graze on grass rather than concentrates



1 hectare of grass per cow



Traditional Hereford Cattle have been grazing the parkland at Courteenhall for many generations



Nutrients from cow manure (like Nitrogen and Sulphur) can support grass growth



Over 250 different species of insects can live in cow manure, which helps with biodiversity, feeding the many mammals and birds that eat them



An increase of organic matter into the soil from cow manure can help to absorb / store more carbon
